
## How to Login to Flowdock using Rally

- NOTE: All GE employees and contractors <u>must always</u> login to Flowdock through Rally. If you have a Rally account, skip to step 2. If you do not have a Rally account, please quickly set one up:
  - a. Go to this URL: https://gesoftware.service-now.com/ Login if GE prompts you to sign in using your SSO and password. Successful login will direct you to our Service-Now instance. This step will prevent any issues moving forward. Go to https://portal.devcl oud.sw.ge.com/


- b. Click the Support Tab
- c. Hover over the Rally logo and click "Request a New User Account"
- d. Submit and you will have access to https://rally1.rallydev.com/slm/login.op
- 2. You will receive a link to Flowdock in your work (Outlook) email.

NOTE: Do not log in using Google. Any accounts registered with a non-GE email will be deleted without warning.

## Sign in to Rally

4. Enter your Rally username which is the primary email address associated with your SSO ID. Leave the password field blank. The login page will redirect you to the GE SSO page if

you are not logged in to SSO (just login as usual), or will automatically authenticate the user if already logged in to SSO.

You will be logged into Flowdock as the username that matches your Rally username (i.e. the primary email address associated with your SSO ID).
